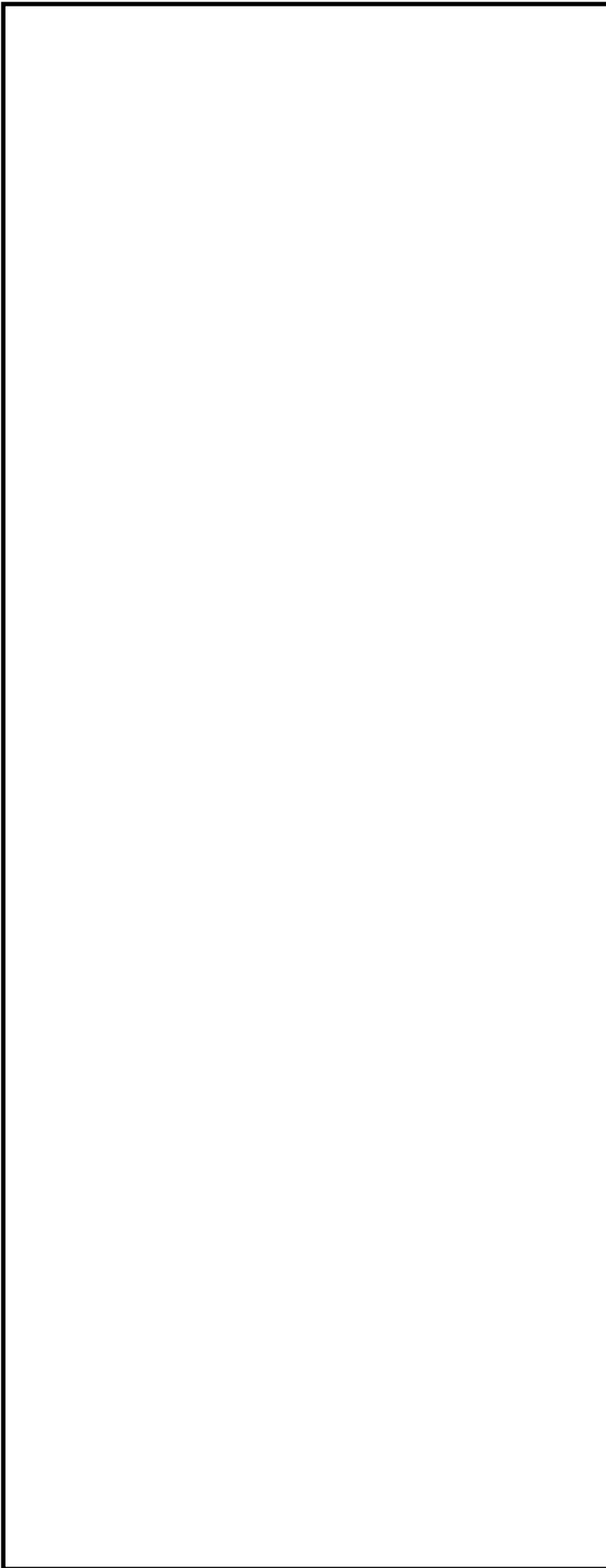

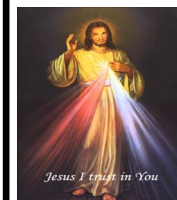
**The April Tabernacle Candle
